


(U) Russian Separate Combined-Arms Brigade (Motorized Rifle/Tank)

(U) This infographic provides information on Russian Separate Combined-Arms Brigade (Motorized Rifle/Tank). The primary combat formation of the Ground Troops is the separate combined-arms brigade, either motorized rifle (MR) or tank. The Ground Troops, or Sukhoputniye Voyska, are the land warfighting component of the Russian Ministry of Defense. There are three basic tables of organization and equipment (TO&Es) for separate MR brigades and one for separate tank brigades. All Russian combined-arms brigades, however, regardless of specific primary combat vehicle, are organized in essentially the same manner.



The organizational structure of a typical tracked APC-equipped independent MR brigade is shown above. Tank and MR brigades differ in organization in that where the MR brigade has three MR battalions, one tank battalion, and an antitank (AT) battalion, the independent tank brigade reverses this basic structure with three tank battalions, one motorized rifle battalion, and no AT battalion. The three MR TO&Es differ from one another in their primary combat vehicle, either wheeled armored personnel carrier (APC) or tracked infantry fighting vehicle (IFV).
