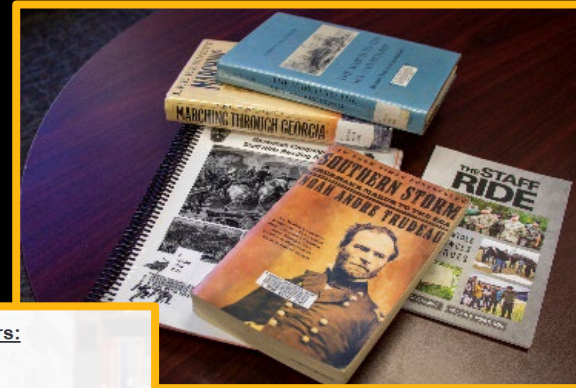

Iraq War

IRAQI INVASION, IRAQ WAR MARCH 20- MAY 1, 2003 UNITED STATES AGAINST IRAQ

Also known as Operation Iraqi Freedom, it was the first stage of the Iraq war and lasted just over a month. In October 2002, the senate was told in a closed session that the Iraq government had means of delivering biological and chemical weapons on mass destruction. Hussein refused to leave Iraq, so the invasion began. It saw the collapse of the Ba'athist regime, which was brutally authoritarian and had ruled for 35 years. The U.S. would not withdraw from Iraq until 2011.

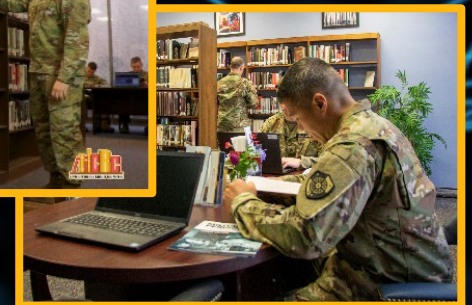

FORT EISENHOWER

In its final report to Congress in 2022 the commission recommended that "Fort Gordon be changed to Fort Eisenhower in commemoration of General of the Army Dwight D. Eisenhower." The basis for their recommendation was that Gen. Eisenhower symbolized "the professionalism, excellence, and joint nature of the base's mission" and because he spent much of his time "preparing for the next war." Gen. Eisenhower serves as an example of devotion to duty and continues to be an inspiration for the present and future soldiers of the Army.

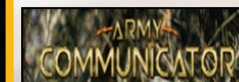

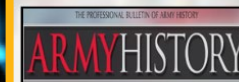
